

AREV 1001: Drawing 1

This course is an introduction and foundation to the visual language of drawing. The course will explore linear and contour drawing, value, and perspective with special emphasis on drawing for science education. Observational drawing is emphasized in this course. Students will learn different mediums of drawing, the vernacular of visual language, how to critique and analyze artwork, as well as how to compose and execute a drawing. This course is to serve as a foundation for visual critique and analysis, and for students to learn basic drawing exercises, styles, and mediums.
