

AGRI 2104: Crop Production II

This course will introduce students to the application of core concepts in crop production management to root and tuber crops, banana and plantain, and selected perennial crops. It focuses on the application of the knowledge of the biology of these crops and the effect of soil and other environmental factors on their growth and development, and to their production management. The course will also provide students with information on good agricultural practices for selected root, tuber and perennial crops, agricultural technologies and production systems for the selected crops, and most importantly, on the knowledge-based competencies required to support practical and entrepreneurial exercises in sustainable production of selected root tuber and perennial crops.
