

Withdrawal

COURSE/INSTITUTE WITHDRAWAL: Withdrawal from a course/institute may occur for academic, disciplinary, health, personal, or financial reasons and may be voluntary or involuntary. Students withdrawing from a course/institute before the end of the semester normally receive the grade notation "W" (withdrawal) on their permanent record for all in-progress courses. Students withdrawing from a course within the final week of the semester will receive a "WF". "W" grades do not affect a student's cumulative GPA; however, a "WF" grade calculates as an "F" and will affect the cumulative GPA.

RE-ADMISSION FOLLOWING WITHDRAWAL: A student who has withdrawn from BAMSI for a period of more than one academic year, whether voluntary or involuntary, is required to apply for readmission.
